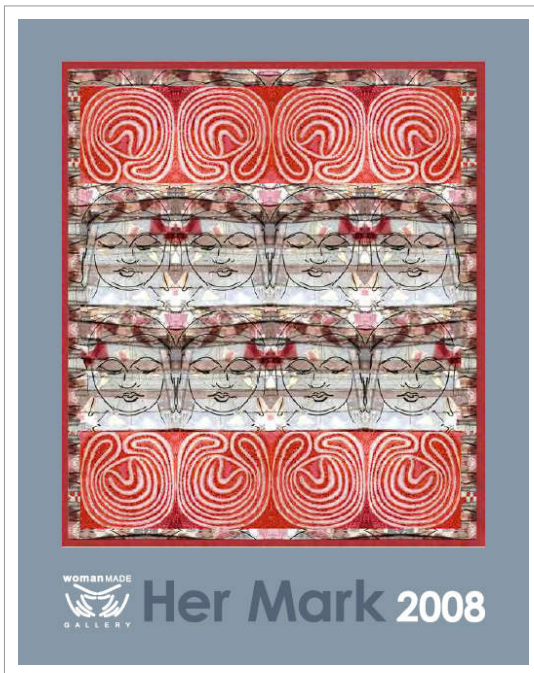

Woman Made Gallery is proud to present its annual publication, the Her Mark 2008 datebook with voices and visions by 42 women. Select work will be on exhibit from August 3rd to 30th. The Artist Reception will be on August 3 from 6 to 9 pm. The Release Party with readings by select poets is scheduled for Sunday, August 5th from 2 to 4pm. Datebooks are available at the Artist Reception and Release Party or may be ordered to be shipped for \$12 per copy plus shipping.

Offering a space to record special events and everyday appointments, the annual Her Mark datebook celebrates both poetry and the visual arts while serving as a practical tool for daily use. Some of the works evoke surprise while others represent lyrical recollections. Diverse in form and content, the works in the datebook offer something for everyone.

Open to women worldwide, contributors are selected via annual poetry and art competitions. This year's poetry jurors included Mars Gamba-Adisa Caulton, Ellen Kort and Simone
