Woman Made Expands to New Site in River West Neighborhood

Chicago, IL, November 7, 2005 -- Woman Made Gallery will open at its new location, 685 N. Milwaukee in the River West Neighborhood on Tuesday, November 15, 2005. The 3,000-plus square foot location provides increased exhibition space and room for an expanded Artisan Gallery and Woman Made's permanent collection.

"We are excited about the added exhibition possibilities and appreciate the street presence that the new location offers," says Woman Made's Executive Director, Beate Minkovski. The new location has added storage space and kitchen facilities, enabling Woman Made to host more events. The on-street location gives Woman Made more visibility and invites walk-in traffic. Woman Made will continue to present both group and invitational exhibitions, as well as workshops and lectures and house the Women's Artists' Resource Library.

Woman Made's first event in its new home is the Annual Holiday Bazaar, opening on November 25th. The Bazaar will run through December 23, with the Artists' Reception on December 2, 2005 from 6 pm to 9pm. The Annual Members' Brunch will be held on Saturday, November 26, 11 am to 1 pm. Members receive a 15 percent discount on all purchases made during the brunch. Non-members may become members during the event and become eligible for the discount. Located within walking distance to the CTA Blue Line and three minutes off the Ogden Avenue I90/94 Exit, the Gallery joins other River West art galleries and non-profit galleries including ARC and Intuit.
