Following the suggestions of our Executive Advisor, Judy Chicago, Woman Made Gallery began the solo show/invitational program in 1999.

In addition to thematic group shows, WMG schedules a variety of invitational shows each year where one artist or a small group of women artists have the opportunity to exhibit a more comprehensive body of work than is possible in the juried group shows. These solo/invitational shows give visitors a chance to experience both a wide variety of works in the group theme shows as well as a more in-depth look into the work of an individual artist.

How do we choose the artists for the solo/invitational exhibitions? WMG does not accept unsolicited proposals but selects the artist from a large pool of individuals whose work is already well-known to the Gallery Directors. The artist has been previously accepted into a group exhibition, is part of the Online Registry: www.womanmade.net and/or has been involved in other functions, possibly as a past juror. Therefore artists are selected by invitation only! The criteria for inclusion is a consistent body of quality work with a strong content, feminist orientation and/or how well the work in the solo show complements the group show planned for the same time period.



The fee for an approximate four-week show taking up the entire lower exhibition area is \$1,000 or \$500 for each of two separate solo show areas which are comprised of at least 40' of wall space each.

The smaller Atrium area with approximately 35' of wall space is available for \$400 per exhibition. Exhibition fees include placing at least ten images on the individual solo/invitational show webpage. Solo/invitational show artists are responsible for printing their own invitations and sending invites to their personal mailing list. WMG includes invited artists in newsletters, in press releases and on the juried group-show invitations in an effort to promote the work of participants.



All artwork is insured while on exhibit. Artwork does not have to be for sale, but artist must include a 40% commission to WMG if their work is for sale. Woman WMG members receive 10% discount on any art

purchases. This amount comes off WMG's commission.
